

New York: District 16

The Need for Services

- 126,240 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New York's 16th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 22 family planning clinics in New York's 16th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 4 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 14 are run by community health centers and 3 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 25,270 women, including 6,070 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 11% are served by hospitals, 19% are served by Planned Parenthood, 56% are served by community health centers and 13% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 4 of the family planning clinics in New York's 16th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New York's 16th congressional district serve 10,140 women, including 2,180 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 48% are served by Planned Parenthood, 33% are served by community health centers and 19% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 16th congressional district.*
