



## New York: District 17

### The Need for Services

- 44,530 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New York's 17th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 10 family planning clinics in New York's 17th congressional district. 1 is run by a health department, 3 are run by hospitals, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 21,750 women, including 6,690 teenagers.\* 5% are served by health departments, 13% are served by hospitals, 49% are served by Planned Parenthood, 28% are served by community health centers and 5% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in New York's 17th congressional district are supported by Title X. 1 is run by a health department, 1 is run by a hospital, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New York's 17th congressional district serve 10,220 women, including 3,290 teenagers.\* 10% are served by health departments, 7% are served by hospitals, 83% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 17th congressional district.*
