



New York: District 18

The Need for Services

- 21,110 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New York's 18th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 12 family planning clinics in New York's 18th congressional district. 3 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 14,100 women, including 2,950 teenagers.* 17% are served by health departments, 1% are served by hospitals, 54% are served by Planned Parenthood, 29% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 7 of the family planning clinics in New York's 18th congressional district are supported by Title X. 3 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New York's 18th congressional district serve 11,680 women, including 2,290 teenagers.* 20% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 65% are served by Planned Parenthood, 15% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 18th congressional district.*
