



New York: District 23

The Need for Services

- 37,220 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New York's 23th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 29 family planning clinics in New York's 23th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 6 are run by hospitals, 12 are run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 8 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 19,820 women, including 6,280 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 6% are served by hospitals, 70% are served by Planned Parenthood, 3% are served by community health centers and 22% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 16 of the family planning clinics in New York's 23th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 11 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 5 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New York's 23th congressional district serve 17,240 women, including 5,560 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 78% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 22% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 23th congressional district.*
