

New York: District 25

The Need for Services

- 31,450 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New York's 25th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 12 family planning clinics in New York's 25th congressional district. 4 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 4 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 16,020 women, including 4,210 teenagers.* 40% are served by health departments, 17% are served by hospitals, 27% are served by Planned Parenthood, 15% are served by community health centers and 1% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 7 of the family planning clinics in New York's 25th congressional district are supported by Title X. 4 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New York's 25th congressional district serve 10,850 women, including 3,320 teenagers.* 59% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 39% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 1% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 25th congressional district.*
