

## New York: District 26

### The Need for Services

- 21,140 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New York's 26th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 13 family planning clinics in New York's 26th congressional district. 6 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 9,550 women, including 3,160 teenagers.\* 29% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 59% are served by Planned Parenthood, 12% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 11 of the family planning clinics in New York's 26th congressional district are supported by Title X. 6 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New York's 26th congressional district serve 8,370 women, including 2,860 teenagers.\* 33% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 67% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 26th congressional district.*
