

New York: District 27

The Need for Services

- 33,490 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New York's 27th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 13 family planning clinics in New York's 27th congressional district. 7 are run by health departments, 4 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 8,090 women, including 2,590 teenagers.* 51% are served by health departments, 5% are served by hospitals, 36% are served by Planned Parenthood, 7% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 12 of the family planning clinics in New York's 27th congressional district are supported by Title X. 7 are run by health departments, 4 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New York's 27th congressional district serve 7,500 women, including 2,440 teenagers.* 55% are served by health departments, 6% are served by hospitals, 39% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 27th congressional district.*
