

New York: District 28

The Need for Services

- 52,330 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New York's 28th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 22 family planning clinics in New York's 28th congressional district. 2 are run by health departments, 6 are run by hospitals, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 8 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 27,740 women, including 9,210 teenagers.* 4% are served by health departments, 22% are served by hospitals, 50% are served by Planned Parenthood, 19% are served by community health centers and 5% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 10 of the family planning clinics in New York's 28th congressional district are supported by Title X. 2 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New York's 28th congressional district serve 17,920 women, including 5,740 teenagers.* 7% are served by health departments, 9% are served by hospitals, 77% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 8% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 28th congressional district.*
