

New York: District 29

The Need for Services

- 27,990 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New York's 29th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 22 family planning clinics in New York's 29th congressional district. 10 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 6 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 6 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 9,210 women, including 3,290 teenagers.* 30% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 52% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 18% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 20 of the family planning clinics in New York's 29th congressional district are supported by Title X. 10 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 6 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 4 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New York's 29th congressional district serve 9,120 women, including 3,260 teenagers.* 31% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 52% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 17% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 29th congressional district.*
