

New York: District 4

The Need for Services

- 17,340 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New York's 4th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 9 family planning clinics in New York's 4th congressional district. 5 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 15,920 women, including 3,100 teenagers.* 29% are served by health departments, 35% are served by hospitals, 36% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 7 of the family planning clinics in New York's 4th congressional district are supported by Title X. 5 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New York's 4th congressional district serve 14,870 women, including 3,000 teenagers.* 31% are served by health departments, 30% are served by hospitals, 39% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 4th congressional district.*
