



New York: District 7

The Need for Services

- 51,250 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in New York's 7th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 5 family planning clinics in New York's 7th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 9,970 women, including 1,290 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 71% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 25% are served by community health centers and 4% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 1 of the family planning clinics in 7th congressional district is supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in New York's 7th congressional district serve 7,080 women, including 960 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 100% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 7th congressional district.*
