



North Carolina: District 1

The Need for Services

- 57,010 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in North Carolina's 1st congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 31 family planning clinics in North Carolina's 1st congressional district. 25 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 24,800 women, including 7,340 teenagers.* 91% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 5% are served by community health centers and 4% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 26 of the family planning clinics in North Carolina's 1st congressional district are supported by Title X. 25 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in North Carolina's 1st congressional district serve 23,540 women, including 6,950 teenagers.* 96% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 4% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 1st congressional district.*
