

North Carolina: District 4

The Need for Services

- 32,640 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in North Carolina's 4th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 12 family planning clinics in North Carolina's 4th congressional district. 5 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 19,420 women, including 4,900 teenagers.* 35% are served by health departments, 20% are served by hospitals, 35% are served by Planned Parenthood, 11% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 6 of the family planning clinics in North Carolina's 4th congressional district are supported by Title X. 5 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in North Carolina's 4th congressional district serve 8,740 women, including 2,090 teenagers.* 77% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 23% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 4th congressional district.*
