



North Dakota: at-large

The Need for Services

- 41,810 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in North Dakota's at-large congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 26 family planning clinics in North Dakota's at-large congressional district. 15 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 9 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 16,010 women, including 4,740 teenagers.* 67% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 1% are served by community health centers and 32% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 17 of the family planning clinics in North Dakota's at-large congressional district are supported by Title X. 15 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 2 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in North Dakota's at-large congressional district serve 13,920 women, including 4,180 teenagers.* 77% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 23% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in at-large congressional district.*
