



Ohio: District 11

The Need for Services

- 62,770 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Ohio's 11th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 19 family planning clinics in Ohio's 11th congressional district. 2 are run by health departments, 8 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 26,340 women, including 6,860 teenagers.* 3% are served by health departments, 56% are served by hospitals, 26% are served by Planned Parenthood, 9% are served by community health centers and 6% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 17 of the family planning clinics in Ohio's 11th congressional district are supported by Title X. 2 are run by health departments, 7 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Ohio's 11th congressional district serve 25,070 women, including 6,480 teenagers.* 3% are served by health departments, 55% are served by hospitals, 26% are served by Planned Parenthood, 9% are served by community health centers and 7% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 11th congressional district.*
