



Ohio: District 12

The Need for Services

- 36,310 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Ohio's 12th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 12 family planning clinics in Ohio's 12th congressional district. 1 is run by a health department, 2 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 11,510 women, including 4,300 teenagers.* 2% are served by health departments, 14% are served by hospitals, 47% are served by Planned Parenthood, 18% are served by community health centers and 19% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 3 of the family planning clinics in Ohio's 12th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Ohio's 12th congressional district serve 5,280 women, including 2,060 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 60% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 40% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 12th congressional district.*
