

Ohio: District 13

The Need for Services

- 31,930 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Ohio's 13th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 6 family planning clinics in Ohio's 13th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 2 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 11,550 women, including 4,060 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 9% are served by hospitals, 49% are served by Planned Parenthood, 10% are served by community health centers and 31% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 4 of the family planning clinics in Ohio's 13th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 2 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Ohio's 13th congressional district serve 9,280 women, including 2,990 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 62% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 38% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 13th congressional district.*
