



## Ohio: District 17

### The Need for Services

- 44,750 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Ohio's 17th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 5 family planning clinics in Ohio's 17th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 8,200 women, including 2,670 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 96% are served by Planned Parenthood, 4% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 3 of the family planning clinics in Ohio's 17th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Ohio's 17th congressional district serve 5,460 women, including 1,920 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 100% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 17th congressional district.*
