



Ohio: District 18

The Need for Services

- 39,430 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Ohio's 18th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 14 family planning clinics in Ohio's 18th congressional district. 4 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 4 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 10,540 women, including 4,140 teenagers.* 25% are served by health departments, 3% are served by hospitals, 23% are served by Planned Parenthood, 5% are served by community health centers and 44% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 8 of the family planning clinics in Ohio's 18th congressional district are supported by Title X. 1 is run by a health department, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 4 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Ohio's 18th congressional district serve 7,500 women, including 3,000 teenagers.* 19% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 19% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 62% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 18th congressional district.*
