



Ohio: District 3

The Need for Services

- 33,010 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Ohio's 3rd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 6 family planning clinics in Ohio's 3rd congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 2 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 6,430 women, including 2,220 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 17% are served by hospitals, 76% are served by Planned Parenthood, 2% are served by community health centers and 6% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 4 of the family planning clinics in Ohio's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 2 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Ohio's 3rd congressional district serve 6,080 women, including 2,170 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 14% are served by hospitals, 80% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 6% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
