

## Ohio: District 4

### The Need for Services

- 31,650 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Ohio's 4th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 10 family planning clinics in Ohio's 4th congressional district. 2 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 6 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 10,290 women, including 3,820 teenagers.\* 31% are served by health departments, 10% are served by hospitals, 59% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 7 of the family planning clinics in Ohio's 4th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 6 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Ohio's 4th congressional district serve 7,110 women, including 2,770 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 14% are served by hospitals, 86% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 4th congressional district.*
