



Ohio: District 5

The Need for Services

- 28,010 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Ohio's 5th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 14 family planning clinics in Ohio's 5th congressional district. 6 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 3 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 6,560 women, including 2,600 teenagers.* 49% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 27% are served by Planned Parenthood, 6% are served by community health centers and 19% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 11 of the family planning clinics in Ohio's 5th congressional district are supported by Title X. 6 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 3 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Ohio's 5th congressional district serve 6,200 women, including 2,490 teenagers.* 52% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 28% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 20% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 5th congressional district.*
