

Ohio: District 7

The Need for Services

- 30,720 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Ohio's 7th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 9 family planning clinics in Ohio's 7th congressional district. 2 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 6,550 women, including 2,490 teenagers.* 19% are served by health departments, 23% are served by hospitals, 41% are served by Planned Parenthood, 8% are served by community health centers and 9% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 6 of the family planning clinics in Ohio's 7th congressional district are supported by Title X. 2 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Ohio's 7th congressional district serve 4,550 women, including 1,870 teenagers.* 28% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 59% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 13% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 7th congressional district.*
