

Ohio: District 9

The Need for Services

- 42,250 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Ohio's 9th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 13 family planning clinics in Ohio's 9th congressional district. 2 are run by health departments, 4 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 14,700 women, including 5,030 teenagers.* 13% are served by health departments, 30% are served by hospitals, 42% are served by Planned Parenthood, 14% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 4 of the family planning clinics in Ohio's 9th congressional district are supported by Title X. 2 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Ohio's 9th congressional district serve 8,180 women, including 2,970 teenagers.* 24% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 76% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 9th congressional district.*
