



Oklahoma: District 2

The Need for Services

- 49,090 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Oklahoma's 2nd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 44 family planning clinics in Oklahoma's 2nd congressional district. 29 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 15 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 23,380 women, including 7,670 teenagers.* 85% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 15% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 33 of the family planning clinics in Oklahoma's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 29 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 4 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Oklahoma's 2nd congressional district serve 20,370 women, including 6,990 teenagers.* 97% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 3% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
