



Oklahoma: District 3

The Need for Services

- 43,870 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Oklahoma's 3rd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 47 family planning clinics in Oklahoma's 3rd congressional district. 34 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 12 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 19,360 women, including 6,380 teenagers.* 93% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 7% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 36 of the family planning clinics in Oklahoma's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 34 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 2 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Oklahoma's 3rd congressional district serve 18,600 women, including 6,210 teenagers.* 96% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 4% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
