

## Oregon: District 1

### The Need for Services

- 29,650 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Oregon's 1st congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 18 family planning clinics in Oregon's 1st congressional district. 10 are run by health departments, 4 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 31,880 women, including 7,500 teenagers.\* 19% are served by health departments, 44% are served by hospitals, 21% are served by Planned Parenthood, 16% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 11 of the family planning clinics in Oregon's 1st congressional district are supported by Title X. 10 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Oregon's 1st congressional district serve 7,080 women, including 1,910 teenagers.\* 86% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 14% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 1st congressional district.*
