

Oregon: District 2

The Need for Services

- 42,030 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Oregon's 2nd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 47 family planning clinics in Oregon's 2nd congressional district. 35 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 7 are run by community health centers and 2 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 27,180 women, including 9,000 teenagers.* 56% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 37% are served by Planned Parenthood, 6% are served by community health centers and 2% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 26 of the family planning clinics in Oregon's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 23 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Oregon's 2nd congressional district serve 21,740 women, including 7,500 teenagers.* 66% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 33% are served by Planned Parenthood, 1% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
