

## Oregon: District 3

### The Need for Services

- 40,140 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Oregon's 3rd congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 17 family planning clinics in Oregon's 3rd congressional district. 13 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 26,650 women, including 5,410 teenagers.\* 20% are served by health departments, 19% are served by hospitals, 61% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 15 of the family planning clinics in Oregon's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 13 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Oregon's 3rd congressional district serve 17,760 women, including 3,570 teenagers.\* 30% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 70% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
