

## Oregon: District 5

### The Need for Services

- 36,570 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Oregon's 5th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 18 family planning clinics in Oregon's 5th congressional district. 10 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 3 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 14,730 women, including 4,100 teenagers.\* 73% are served by health departments, 6% are served by hospitals, 8% are served by Planned Parenthood, 11% are served by community health centers and 2% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 10 of the family planning clinics in Oregon's 5th congressional district are supported by Title X. 10 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Oregon's 5th congressional district serve 10,800 women, including 3,280 teenagers.\* 100% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 5th congressional district.*
