

## Pennsylvania: District 1

### The Need for Services

- 91,950 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Pennsylvania's 1st congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 35 family planning clinics in Pennsylvania's 1st congressional district. 2 are run by health departments, 22 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 6 are run by community health centers and 2 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 52,070 women, including 16,200 teenagers.\* 8% are served by health departments, 45% are served by hospitals, 34% are served by Planned Parenthood, 13% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 31 of the family planning clinics in Pennsylvania's 1st congressional district are supported by Title X. 2 are run by health departments, 20 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Pennsylvania's 1st congressional district serve 50,270 women, including 15,730 teenagers.\* 8% are served by health departments, 45% are served by hospitals, 35% are served by Planned Parenthood, 12% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 1st congressional district.*
