

## Pennsylvania: District 10

### The Need for Services

- 32,930 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Pennsylvania's 10th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 20 family planning clinics in Pennsylvania's 10th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 10 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 8 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 13,270 women, including 4,130 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 59% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 1% are served by community health centers and 40% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 19 of the family planning clinics in Pennsylvania's 10th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 9 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 8 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Pennsylvania's 10th congressional district serve 12,800 women, including 4,000 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 57% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 1% are served by community health centers and 41% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 10th congressional district.*
