

Pennsylvania: District 12

The Need for Services

- 46,340 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Pennsylvania's 12th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 17 family planning clinics in Pennsylvania's 12th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 4 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 7 are run by community health centers and 5 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 15,810 women, including 5,030 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 31% are served by hospitals, 8% are served by Planned Parenthood, 10% are served by community health centers and 51% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 15 of the family planning clinics in Pennsylvania's 12th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 7 are run by community health centers and 5 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Pennsylvania's 12th congressional district serve 14,160 women, including 4,290 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 23% are served by hospitals, 9% are served by Planned Parenthood, 11% are served by community health centers and 57% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 12th congressional district.*
