

Pennsylvania: District 13

The Need for Services

- 21,880 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Pennsylvania's 13th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 4 family planning clinics in Pennsylvania's 13th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 7,700 women, including 2,530 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 20% are served by hospitals, 80% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 3 of the family planning clinics in Pennsylvania's 13th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Pennsylvania's 13th congressional district serve 6,540 women, including 2,240 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 5% are served by hospitals, 95% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 13th congressional district.*
