

Pennsylvania: District 14

The Need for Services

- 59,540 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Pennsylvania's 14th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 27 family planning clinics in Pennsylvania's 14th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 12 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 7 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 20,900 women, including 5,040 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 60% are served by hospitals, 11% are served by Planned Parenthood, 9% are served by community health centers and 20% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 25 of the family planning clinics in Pennsylvania's 14th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 12 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 4 are run by community health centers and 7 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Pennsylvania's 14th congressional district serve 19,380 women, including 4,660 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 65% are served by hospitals, 9% are served by Planned Parenthood, 5% are served by community health centers and 22% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 14th congressional district.*
