



## Pennsylvania: District 16

### The Need for Services

- 32,760 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Pennsylvania's 16th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 12 family planning clinics in Pennsylvania's 16th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 6 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 3 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 16,090 women, including 4,750 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 11% are served by hospitals, 81% are served by Planned Parenthood, 1% are served by community health centers and 8% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 8 of the family planning clinics in Pennsylvania's 16th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 4 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 3 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Pennsylvania's 16th congressional district serve 9,000 women, including 2,610 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 85% are served by Planned Parenthood, 2% are served by community health centers and 14% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 16th congressional district.*
