

Pennsylvania: District 19

The Need for Services

- 24,850 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Pennsylvania's 19th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 12 family planning clinics in Pennsylvania's 19th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 7 are run by Planned Parenthood, 4 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 13,890 women, including 4,070 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 10% are served by hospitals, 85% are served by Planned Parenthood, 5% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 11 of the family planning clinics in Pennsylvania's 19th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 6 are run by Planned Parenthood, 4 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Pennsylvania's 19th congressional district serve 13,180 women, including 3,850 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 11% are served by hospitals, 84% are served by Planned Parenthood, 5% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 19th congressional district.*
