

## Pennsylvania: District 2

### The Need for Services

- 84,990 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Pennsylvania's 2nd congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 37 family planning clinics in Pennsylvania's 2nd congressional district. 7 are run by health departments, 12 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 10 are run by community health centers and 8 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 27,040 women, including 7,060 teenagers.\* 30% are served by health departments, 36% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 29% are served by community health centers and 6% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 30 of the family planning clinics in Pennsylvania's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 7 are run by health departments, 11 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 7 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Pennsylvania's 2nd congressional district serve 22,720 women, including 5,980 teenagers.\* 35% are served by health departments, 39% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 21% are served by community health centers and 4% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
