



Pennsylvania: District 3

The Need for Services

- 40,930 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Pennsylvania's 3rd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 21 family planning clinics in Pennsylvania's 3rd congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 13 are run by community health centers and 8 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 17,180 women, including 5,140 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 32% are served by community health centers and 68% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 8 of the family planning clinics in Pennsylvania's 3rd congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 8 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Pennsylvania's 3rd congressional district serve 11,720 women, including 3,750 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 100% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 3rd congressional district.*
