



Pennsylvania: District 5

The Need for Services

- 50,940 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Pennsylvania's 5th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 26 family planning clinics in Pennsylvania's 5th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 5 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 9 are run by community health centers and 11 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 18,920 women, including 5,580 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 8% are served by hospitals, 2% are served by Planned Parenthood, 12% are served by community health centers and 78% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 22 of the family planning clinics in Pennsylvania's 5th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 5 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 11 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Pennsylvania's 5th congressional district serve 17,750 women, including 5,400 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 8% are served by hospitals, 2% are served by Planned Parenthood, 6% are served by community health centers and 84% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 5th congressional district.*
