

Pennsylvania: District 6

The Need for Services

- 20,980 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Pennsylvania's 6th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 10 family planning clinics in Pennsylvania's 6th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 3 are run by hospitals, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 11,760 women, including 3,370 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 18% are served by hospitals, 69% are served by Planned Parenthood, 5% are served by community health centers and 8% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 9 of the family planning clinics in Pennsylvania's 6th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 5 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Pennsylvania's 6th congressional district serve 11,020 women, including 3,190 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 13% are served by hospitals, 74% are served by Planned Parenthood, 5% are served by community health centers and 8% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 6th congressional district.*
