

Pennsylvania: District 9

The Need for Services

- 36,180 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Pennsylvania's 9th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 14 family planning clinics in Pennsylvania's 9th congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 6 are run by community health centers and 6 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 18,950 women, including 4,190 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 20% are served by hospitals, 4% are served by Planned Parenthood, 31% are served by community health centers and 45% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 13 of the family planning clinics in Pennsylvania's 9th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 6 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Pennsylvania's 9th congressional district serve 18,700 women, including 4,040 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 20% are served by hospitals, 5% are served by Planned Parenthood, 30% are served by community health centers and 46% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 9th congressional district.*
