

Rhode Island: District 1

The Need for Services

- 33,580 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Rhode Island's 1st congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 12 family planning clinics in Rhode Island's 1st congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 6 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 6,860 women, including 1,480 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 5% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 60% are served by community health centers and 35% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 9 of the family planning clinics in Rhode Island's 1st congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 5 are run by community health centers and 3 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Rhode Island's 1st congressional district serve 6,010 women, including 1,390 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 5% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 69% are served by community health centers and 26% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 1st congressional district.*
