

Rhode Island: District 2

The Need for Services

- 32,790 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Rhode Island's 2nd congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 10 family planning clinics in Rhode Island's 2nd congressional district. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 4 are run by community health centers and 4 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 9,330 women, including 2,720 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 13% are served by hospitals, 32% are served by Planned Parenthood, 23% are served by community health centers and 32% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 8 of the family planning clinics in Rhode Island's 2nd congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 3 are run by community health centers and 4 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Rhode Island's 2nd congressional district serve 7,670 women, including 2,250 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 39% are served by Planned Parenthood, 22% are served by community health centers and 39% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 2nd congressional district.*
