

## Tennessee: District 4

### The Need for Services

- 37,830 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Tennessee's 4th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 38 family planning clinics in Tennessee's 4th congressional district. 26 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 9 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 14,830 women, including 5,670 teenagers.\* 63% are served by health departments, 9% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 27% are served by community health centers and 1% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 26 of the family planning clinics in Tennessee's 4th congressional district are supported by Title X. 26 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 0 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Tennessee's 4th congressional district serve 9,390 women, including 3,980 teenagers.\* 100% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 0% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 4th congressional district.*
