

## Tennessee: District 5

### The Need for Services

- 35,640 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Tennessee's 5th congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 10 family planning clinics in Tennessee's 5th congressional district. 4 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 4 are run by community health centers and 0 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 7,930 women, including 3,170 teenagers.\* 38% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 46% are served by Planned Parenthood, 15% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in Tennessee's 5th congressional district are supported by Title X. 4 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Tennessee's 5th congressional district serve 6,250 women, including 2,240 teenagers.\* 49% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 51% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 5th congressional district.*
