

## Texas: District 1

### The Need for Services

- 42,170 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Texas's 1st congressional district.

### Meeting the Need

- There are 16 family planning clinics in Texas's 1st congressional district. 8 are run by health departments, 2 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 4 are run by community health centers and 1 is run by an other type of agency.
- Together, these clinics serve 9,710 women, including 3,170 teenagers.\* 26% are served by health departments, 25% are served by hospitals, 21% are served by Planned Parenthood, 18% are served by community health centers and 10% are served by other types of agencies.

### The Key Role of Title X

- 5 of the family planning clinics in Texas's 1st congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 2 are run by community health centers and 1 is served by an other type of agency.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Texas's 1st congressional district serve 5,590 women, including 1,790 teenagers.\* 0% are served by health departments, 24% are served by hospitals, 37% are served by Planned Parenthood, 22% are served by community health centers and 17% are served by other types of agencies.

*\* These women may or may not live in 1st congressional district.*
