

Texas: District 11

The Need for Services

- 36,580 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Texas's 11th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 12 family planning clinics in Texas's 11th congressional district. 2 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 1 is run by a community health center and 7 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 16,460 women, including 4,380 teenagers.* 21% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 55% are served by Planned Parenthood, 2% are served by community health centers and 22% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 10 of the family planning clinics in Texas's 11th congressional district are supported by Title X. 2 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 7 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Texas's 11th congressional district serve 13,300 women, including 3,510 teenagers.* 26% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 47% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 27% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 11th congressional district.*
