

Texas: District 12

The Need for Services

- 26,850 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Texas's 12th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 11 family planning clinics in Texas's 12th congressional district. 2 are run by health departments, 1 is run by a hospital, 2 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 6 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 9,220 women, including 3,120 teenagers.* 5% are served by health departments, 3% are served by hospitals, 55% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 37% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 1 of the family planning clinics in 12th congressional district is supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 1 is run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 0 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Texas's 12th congressional district serve 2,940 women, including 700 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 100% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 0% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 12th congressional district.*
