

Texas: District 15

The Need for Services

- 75,740 women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies live in Texas's 15th congressional district.

Meeting the Need

- There are 27 family planning clinics in Texas's 15th congressional district. 11 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 8 are run by Planned Parenthood, 4 are run by community health centers and 4 are run by other types of agencies.
- Together, these clinics serve 34,160 women, including 7,270 teenagers.* 19% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 58% are served by Planned Parenthood, 14% are served by community health centers and 9% are served by other types of agencies.

The Key Role of Title X

- 7 of the family planning clinics in Texas's 15th congressional district are supported by Title X. 0 are run by health departments, 0 are run by hospitals, 3 are run by Planned Parenthood, 0 are run by community health centers and 4 are served by other types of agencies.
- These Title X-supported clinics in Texas's 15th congressional district serve 6,310 women, including 1,460 teenagers.* 0% are served by health departments, 0% are served by hospitals, 50% are served by Planned Parenthood, 0% are served by community health centers and 50% are served by other types of agencies.

** These women may or may not live in 15th congressional district.*
